

ERM 613 94.78 Feet NAVD. Downstream side of the Front Street Bridge over the right bank of the East Fork. Brass disk stamped "ISSQ FLOOD BM-7" set in the concrete walk.

ERM 614 107.32 Feet NAVD. Downstream side of the NE Dogwood Street Bridge over the left bank of the East Fork. Brass disk stamped "ISSQ FLOOD BM-8" set in the concrete walk.

ERM 241 130.07 Feet NAVD. Corner of Birch Street and 5th Avenue. Top and end of most riverward concrete retaining wall for garage.

ERM 617 96.68 Feet NAVD. Brass disk in concrete planter at the intersection of Rainier Blvd. and Front Street N. Stamped "KING COUNTY KC-D-18 1993".


